

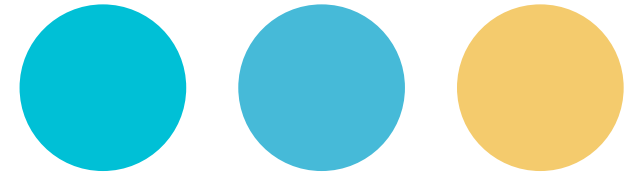
# The Zonta International Centennial Logo



## Typography

**Hypatia Sans Pro:** Hypatia Regular **Hypatia Semibold**  
 Hypatia Sans Pro is the font used in the word “ZONTA” within the Centennial Logo. Hypatia Sans Pro is a licensed Adobe font. Hypatia Sans Pro should be used in headings and subheadings in print and electronic communications when available. There is a cost associated with using this font. When creating design using the Centennial Logo with other colors from the Zonta International Brand Identity Guidelines, it is recommended that you use the secondary hues and not the full 100 percent colors, with exception to the Gold and Cool Gray.

**Lato:** Lato **Lato Bold** *Lato Italic* **Lato Bold Italic**  
 Lato is the font used in “YEARS” within the Centennial Logo. Lato is an open source font that is available for free. Lato should be used for headings and subheadings when Hypatia Sans Pro is unavailable, or as body copy. To download the Lato font, go to <http://www.latofonts.com>.

**Arial:** Arial Arial Narrow *Arial Italic* **Arial Bold** **Arial Bold Italic**  
 Arial should be used in body copy.

## Guidelines for Use

The Centennial Logo may not be altered in any way.

- Do not stretch or skew the logo
- Do not recolor the logo
- Do not add any other elements to the logo
- Do not overlap the logo to any other design elements

The Centennial Logo shall be used in place of the Zonta International, Zonta district and Zonta club logos when used on the following materials during the 2018-2020 Biennium:

- Letterhead
- Envelopes
- Invitations
- Banners
- Name Badges
- Business Cards
- Buttons and pins
- Documents for Centennial Programs

The Zonta International, Zonta district and Zonta club logos will continue to be used on:

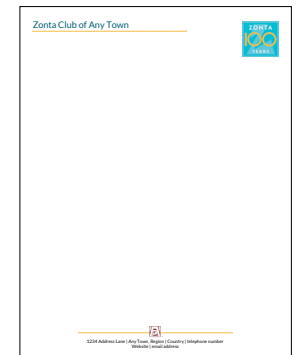
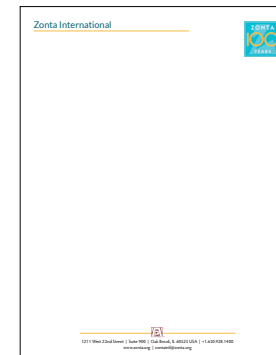
- Policies
- Manuals
- Operational documents
- Items to be used beyond the 2018-2020 Biennium

## Using the Centennial Logo along with the Emblem

- When creating design with the Centennial Logo, include the emblem within the design.
- The Centennial Logo and the emblem shall not be used next to one another, but instead used on opposite sides of work, or opposite ends of documents.
- The Centennial Logo and the emblem shall either be the same size, or the “Z” of ZONTA within the Centennial Logo shall be the same size of the Z element within the emblem.
