<p>What did the Education Project Involve?</p>	<p>A reading to educate students in high schools to respect women and every person by a musician and an actress on a text wrote with the Zonta Club Alessandria supervision.</p>
<p>Why was the Project chosen?</p>	<p>Word injuries are "the words that hurt more than blows" as the fourteen year old Carolina Picchio wrote in her farewell note, before committing suicide overwhelmed by bullying and violence exercised against her by some of her peers. These are the words that undermine people's serenity, those that burn like unlit cigarettes on the skin, those that bounce off the tip of the lips and then hit us in the back. And they are, in particular, the words that muddy, offend, devastate women, fueled by machismo, by clichés and by prejudices, open wounds of our society still too far from the idea of real equality between the sexes. Are the words not said, but written in chat by children and adults who do not know the destructive power of words, spread in comments on social networks.</p>
<p>Who benefitted from the project</p>	<p>The first beneficiaries are the 160 students from 4 high schools connected remotely during the recording of the reading. Then all those who viewed the video on YouTube, on the websites of the schools and of the Municipality of Alessandria which sponsored the event</p>
<p>What results were achieved?</p>	<p>Involvement of the City of Alessandria, in particular of the Department and the Council for Equal Opportunities, of the Union of Journalists of Piedmont, of the association of alumni of the "Leonardo da Vinci" High School, of the 5th year students of 4 different courses of the "Leonardo da Vinci" High School. Those 160 students are more aware of the damage done by words often used inappropriately, of the bad example offered by some adults. "Ferite da Parole" gets an extraordinary media coverage before and after the event. It was the highlight of the Women's Month of the City of Alessandria</p>
<p>How did the project fulfill ZI Mission?</p>	<p>Education to Respect is part of the actions to prevent violence against women: Zonta Club Alessandria is very careful to combine service initiatives with advocacy actions and education, matched with communication, represents the perfect synthesis. This activity is part of the ZONTA SAYS NO TO VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN campaign, which in Alessandria is carried out throughout the year.</p>

“EDUCATION PROGRAM AMELIA EARHART DAYS - SCIENCE ENTREPRENEURSHIP FOR GIRLS”

<p>What did the Education Project Involve?</p>	<p>The Amelia Earhart days - Science Entrepreneurship for Girls project aims to encourage girls in STEM. The project has the following goals:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • to provoke girls to develop their scientific interests by observing and participating in natural science experiments and technical installations, and thus get acquainted with the opportunities that each science offers and • to acquaint the public with the scholarship in the name of Amelia Earhart, given every year by Zonta International. <p>The project was implemented with the partnership of Regional Department of Education of Burgas, Municipality of Burgas and is under the patronage of the District Governor of the city.</p> <p>It took place in Vocational School of Mechanical Electrical Engineering And Electronics – Burgas for two days and included practical workshops in physics, chemistry, biology, astronomy, robotics and electronics, led by highly qualified University professors. Each workshop was attended by 15 to 20 girls in two sessions (morning from 9:30 and afternoon from 13:00), lasting 120 minutes. Every participant received gifts, set of equipment for each of the workshops and PR documents reg. Zonta International and Amelia Earhart Fellowship.</p> <p>The second day was an Open Science Day (family day) for entrepreneurship through science, and visitors, mainly parents with children, visited and get acquainted with the various science and technology stands.</p>
<p>Why was the Project chosen?</p>	<p>To encourage the girls and adolescents in STEM. The project gives valuable educational support, teaches and nurtures a love for science of young girls at school age.</p>
<p>Who benefitted from the project?</p>	<p>The project Amelia Earhart days - entitled Entrepreneurship through science is for girls from fifth to eighth grade from all secondary schools. Girls from 18 secondary schools and vocational high schools from Burgas district took part with a total of 534 participants only in practical workshops on the first day and over 2000 visitors on the second day</p>
<p>What results were achieved?</p>	<p>The project was widely covered by National and regional media, electronic sites, including articles and interviews with the president of the club and other Zontians and had a wide response among the public of the city.</p> <p>As a consequence of the extremely interesting scientific information presented by highly qualified university professors, the Club of Girls engaged in science was established.</p>
<p>How did the project fulfill ZI Mission?</p>	<p>The project was widely covered by National and regional media, electronic sites, including articles and interviews with the president of the club and other Zontians and had a wide response among the public of the city.</p> <p>As a consequence of the extremely interesting scientific information presented by highly qualified university professors, the Club of Girls engaged in science was established.</p>

<p>What did the Education Project Involve?</p>	<p>This educational project involves mentoring activities, civic education, entrepreneurship for young high school students, including members of ZClub Spiru Haret Prahova, improving their leadership skills, promoting volunteering, advocacy activities</p>
<p>Why was the Project chosen?</p>	<p>This project was chosen because the activity of our club, in partnership with National College Spiru Haret, showed us that there is a permanent need for such a project, given the change of generations in high school, each new generation coming up with their own challenges, opportunities and questions. Also, Pandemic Covid 19, determined us to choose this project, whose activities we can organize remotely, in lockdown conditions, etc., included online meetings.</p>
<p>Who benefitted from project?</p>	<p>Direct beneficiaries - 30 members of Z CLUB Spiru Haret Prahova, Spiru Haret College students - about 1000 students, teachers; Indirect beneficiaries are students from other colleges in the city we work with, parents of students, community.</p>
<p>What results were achieved?</p>	<p>Every school year, in the last three years, we have organized: 5 seminars / year- leadership for youth, communication, health education, about Bullying, entrepreneurship, about women role in society. - Zonta Says NO campaign within the college; - a contest / each year -technical-scientific -Amelia Earhart month; - annual organization of a digital skills course for teachers with support and mentoring from students; In the future we have a goal to be able to build an unconventional space, in the inner courtyard of the College, which would allow us to meet physically in pandemic conditions that impose measures of social distance and to endow this space with furniture, computers, etc.</p>
<p>How did the project fulfill ZI Mission?</p>	<p>This project supports the mission of Zonta, because the development of the listed skills among young people - girls and boys alike (more than 60% of students are girls) cultivates values such as self-esteem, teamwork, desire to learn constantly and combat violent manifestations and discriminatory act, give young generations a good start in social life as independent and educated persons. We try to encourage, especially young women, to be more assertive, more independent, to not accept inadequate behavior from boys and men, to be able to recognize the dangerous situations such as pornography, sexual discrimination, human traffic, cyber bullying. In addition, the best aspect of this project is his permanent status; we can do it annually, for each generation of students</p>
